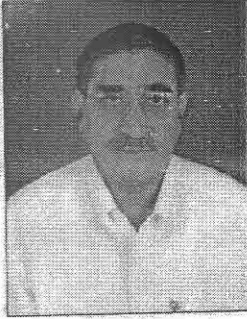

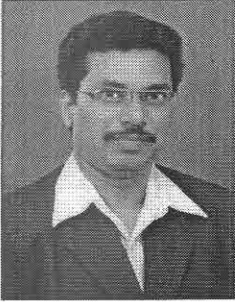

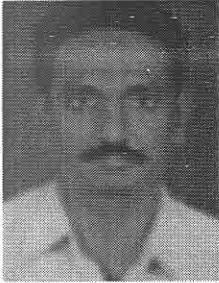

### 3. History of the Department from the Starting:

#### DEPARTMENT OF DERMATOLOGY:

In the first few years of the Department of Dermatology, there was no Post graduation. There was only patient management and a lecturer cadre was head in the department conduct the outpatient and inpatient activities. Dr. N.A. Pantulu was the first lecturer and Head of the Department of Dermatology. The first qualified professor of Dermatology was Dr.V.V.Subrahmanyam, under who The Diploma course in Dermatology was started in June, 1978 and subsequently in January 1983 the MD course was started under the same professor.

#### DEPARTMENT OF VENEREOLOGY:

The first HOD is Dr. N.V.S.Rama Rao MBBS DV, from September 1962 to May 1978. The next Professor and HOD is Dr. K.V. Rama Raju MD DV from May 1978 to July 1999. The first Diploma started in March 1977 and the first MD Degree was started in 1983.

Both the departments were clubbed in 2003 and DVL degrees are being awarded. After the introduction of Hospital Development Society the Department is enriched with equipment like Dermabrasion Machine, Radio Frequency Cautery, Bifircator, Wood's Lamp and teaching aids like computer, LCD Projector and screen. The HDS purchased PUVA chamber with computer equipments, narrow band UVB panel and chamber and Iontophoresis unit.

The male DVL ward with 20 beds is situated in the hospital premises. For female patients, Medical (M6) female ward is allotted with a strength of 5 beds and surgical(S5) female ward with a strength of 5 beds. For emergency cases acute medical care unit situated in the Department of Medicine is utilized. Leprosy ward is situated near by the hospital with a capacity of 20 beds under the control of Leprosy Medical Officer and Addl. DM&HO(AIDS&Leprosy). The **Urban Leprosy Clinic** is working in Dermatology O.P. regulary since 32 years. The **Suraksha Clinic of APSACs** is attached to V.D O.P. in November, 2008 and is extending services and giving kits to need STI/AIDS patients. During this period of three decades the department has attained considerable academic excellence in various subjects in the field of Dermatology, Venereology and Leprosy. The department staff are participating in National AIDS Control Programme, and National STD/RTI Control Programme by way of undergoing training programmes and training the local staff and supervising the RTI clinics.

**10. Rare surgical procedures performed-a) RARE CASES:**

**1. XERODERMA PIGMENTOSA**



A female patient aged 9 yrs came with pigmentary lesions since 1 ½ yr of age.

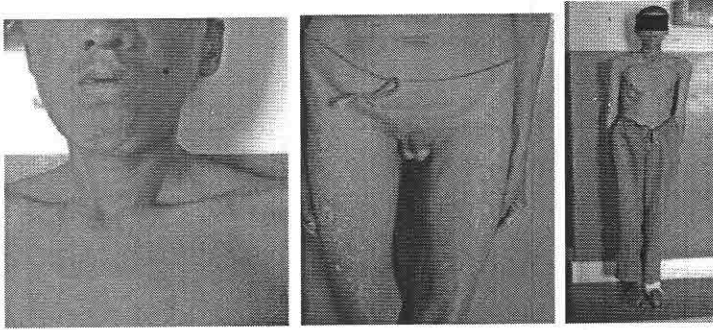
O/E: Freckle like macules present all over the body.

The lesions are ranging from few mm to 1-2cm irregular lesions.

Achromic macules interspersed with these.

The skin dry, scaly and wrinkled.

## 2. KLIENFELTER'S SYNDROME

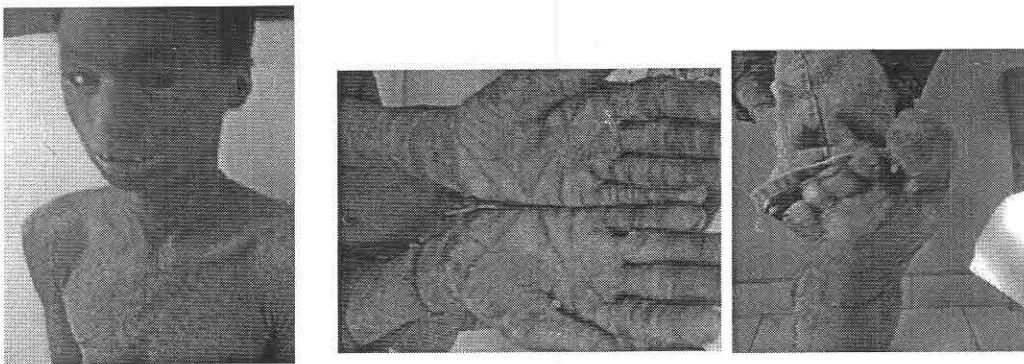


A male patient aged 25yrs was referred from M3 ward for non healing ulcer left leg.

O/E: The patient is tall statured 6' 1" with long lower limbs associated with mental retardation, decreased facial and sexual hair, gynaecomastia, hypogonadism – small penis and small testis. Refractory leg ulcer on left leg present.

Patient absconded before buccal smear was done.

## 3. LAMELLAR ICTHYOSIS



A male patient aged 15yrs came with the complaint of scaling skin lesions all over the body since birth.

O/E: The scales are large quadrilateral free at the edges and adherent in the center.

The palms and soles -massive diffuse hyper kerstosis with maceration and fissuring.

Bilateral ectropion present. Treated with ISOTRTINOIN 20 mg/kg there is good clinical response.

The symptoms recurred after discontunation of therapy.

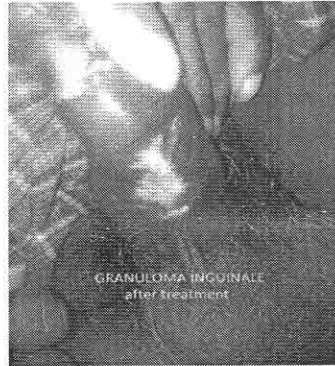
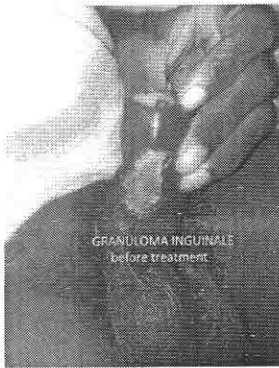
## 4. TUBEROUS SCLEROSIS



A female patient aged 25yrs came with complaints of dark coloured , elevated , hyperpigmented lesions on the face since 8yrs of age. O/E: Adenoma sebaceum- reddish brown smooth dome shaped papules present on face. Ash leaf macule –present on right leg. Shaw green patch- localized leathery, yellow green plaque present on right lumbo sacral area.

## 5. GRANULOMA INGUINALE

A male patient of age 65yrs came with single 5x3 cm non healing ulcer on the shaft of the penis since 1month, appeared as small papule and progressed to the present stage. He took local medication. On examination the ulcer is 5x3 cm size, oval shape, base is pinkish granular tissue, non healing white fibrous borders, undermined edges, firm in consistency. On histo pathological examination from the edge of the ulcer showed pseudoepitheliomatosis consistent with GRANULOMA INGUINALE. Treatment with Tab. COTRIMOXAZOLE DS give daily once for 21 days as a clinical trial and it was cured, otherwise this case was thought to be treated as carcinoma penis and amputation of penis might have been done.

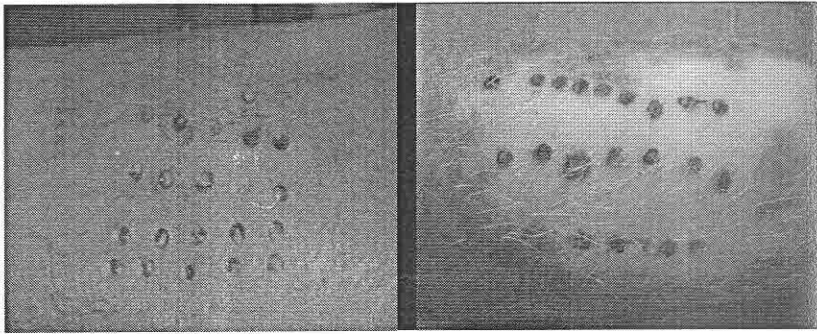

Naidu** of Kakinada in them.
