ABOUT RANGARAYA MEDICAL COLLEGE

Rangaraya Medical College, Kakinada is one the Noble and Premier Government Medical Colleges in Andhra Pradesh established in 1958. It is affiliated to Dr.NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada. According to Time of India, this institution has ranked 2nd in the erstwhile state of Andhra Pradesh and 17th among the Medical Colleges in India. This institution is the administrative controlling authority of Professors, Associate Professors and Assistant Professors working in Government General Hospital, Kakinada which is providing services to the poor patients in East & West Godavari Districts. This institution is also delivering 200 efficient Undergraduate doctors, 111 Post Graduate Doctors and 6 super specialists every year to serve the nation. It is also serving the rural people through Govt.Rural Health Center, G.Mamidada and by arranging regular eye & health camps throughout the East & West Godavari Districts.

It is submitted, this institution has been selected as One of the Five Medical Colleges in the Country to implement a pilot project on "Integration of Medical Education on Primary & Secondary Health Care". This institution is one among the eight medical colleges in the country which offers D.M (Neonatology) super specialty course. The Government of India is implementing their new projects in health sector through this college like Multi Disciplinary Research Unit and Virology Lab through Indian Council of Medical Research, National Medical College Network (NMCN), National Knowledge Network, Telemedicine etc.

The following matter briefly describes the origins of Rangaraya Medical College and its attached teaching hospital (Government General Hospital, Kakinada).

Rangaraya Medical College – History

Rangaraya Medical College was started by the dedicated efforts by Dr. M.V.Krishnarao who was a minister of Education in the cabinet of Sri Rajaji in the composite Madras state. He was later joined by Colonel Dr.D.S.Raju, M R C P, who was a personal physician of Sri Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose and later Deputy Minister of Defence and Health in the cabinet of Sri Jawaharlal Nehru.

Though their efforts started in 1955 the college became a reality on 2nd April 1958 in a meeting in Kakinada attended by Sri Neelam Sanjiva Reddy, the then Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh in the house of Dr. Lakkaraju Subbarao where the Rao Venkata Kumara Mahipati Surya Rau, the Maharaja of Pithapuram leased the Palatial Orphanage buildings. Two Lecture halls and a Dissection hall were newly constructed. The Rangaraya Medical College was inaugurated on 17 November 1958 by Sri. Neelam Sanjeeva Reddy, then Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh. One hundred students were admitted in the first year. Their teaching work was initiated on 15 August 1958 by late Dr. V. S. Krishna, Vice Chancellor of the Andhra University. The idea was conceived on Feb 24 by Col.D.S.Raju and his associates. The society was formed on 16 April, the first lecture was delivered by Dr. Moturu Bhanu Sankar Prasad on Sept 17.

As a first step a Society called "Kakinada Medical Education Society" was registered on 16th April 1958 to oversee the starting of the Medical College by July 1958 with the core aims of providing Medical education, Medical research and Medical service

While Col. Raju (first president of Kakinada Medical Education Society) was engaged in the task of collecting donations to the proposed medical college, Dr M V Krishnarao did all the spade work for starting the institution. Eminent doctors like I V Jogarao, P V N Raju, K Chandra Rao, A Perisastry, B Venkata Raju and P R Hari extended a helping hand. The then Municipal Chairman Sri Dantu Bhaskara Rao co-operated with the endeavor.

The Munificent donors of East and West Godavari donated liberally for this medical college, of which Sri Mullapudi Harichandra Prasad donated Rs.5,00,000/- magnanimously. In gratitude to the generous donation, the Medical Education Society named the college after his Brother-in-law and Grandfather, Late Sri Pendyala Sriramachandra Venkata Krishna Rangarao (Ranga) and Sri Mullapudi Venkatarayadu (Raya) respectively Hence the name RANGARAYA Medical College.

Sri Kotamarti Venkanna donated 6 acres and 7 cents of land to locate the Men's Hostel buildings. The college owns sites to the extent of 53.83 acres in its various campuses.

The first Principal was Sri Basudeva Narayana, Eminent teacher of Physiology, Retired Vice-Chancellor of Patna University and Vice President of Indian Medical Council. The first professor of Anatomy was Dr. S. L. Bose and Dr. D. Narayanarao was the first Bio-chemistry professor.

In June 1958, Andhra University officials inspected the pre-clinical departments and gave permission for starting of the new 'Sri Rangaraya Memorial Medical College' for a period of two years.

The college started on 17 September 1958 with the introductory speech of Dr. V. S. Krishna, Vice Chancellor of Andhra University followed by the first lecture delivered by Sri Gorti Sankarabhanu, of the Chemistry department.

The emblem of the college was designed by making minor changes to the emblem of the Andhra University. The inscription on it – 'Sarve santu Niramaya' was suggested by Sri Samavedam Jankirama Sastry. It was from the holy Vedas, and means – 'let everybody become healthy'.

Officially the college was started by the then Chief Minister and Minister of Health of Andhra Pradesh Sri Neelam Sanjiva Reddy on 17 November 1958.

The Biochemistry lecture galleries

The New lecture gallery was started by Sri D. P. Karmarkar, the then Central Minister for Health in the presence of Sri J. V. Narasingarao, AP State Minister on Dt. 23 January 1959.

Pydah Venkanna & Ramakrishnayya's lecture hall – Now Sub-library

On date 12th December 1969 a lecture gallery named 'Sri Pydah Venkanna & Ramakrishnayya's lecture gallery' (presently housing the Sub-library), was inaugurated by Sri. Pydah Sriramakrishna Murthy, Patron member of Medical Education Society.

The student's Canteen in the Main College Campus was inaugurated by Sri B. Ramachandra Rao, Founder member of Medical Education Society on date 12th December 1969.

NCC building (now housing the Gymnasium) was inaugurated by Dr. B. V. L. N. Raju, Founder member of Medical Education Society on date 12th December 1969.

The Indoor Shuttlecock Badminton court was inaugurated by Dr. K. Chandra Rao, Vice President of Medical Education Society, on date 12th December 1969 in the Main college campus.

The College Guest house

The college Guest House was declared open by Dr. C. D. Deshmukh on Dt. 18th January 1970, in the Main College campus. It was since provided with air conditioners.

On 14 October 1959 Government of Andhra Pradesh notified the existing District Head Quarters Hospital in Kakinada as the Teaching Hospital attached to the Rangaraya Medical College.

The first college day was held on 13 March 1960 with Sri. M. Pallamaraju and Sri. P. V. G. Raju as Chief guests.

The Anatomy and Physiology block

Vice president of India Sri Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan laid the foundation stone for the Anatomy and physiology block on Dt. 04 August 1961. A music concert by Sri Mangalampalli Balamuralikrishna was organized the same evening where the first College magazine was handed over to Sri Radhakrishna by Dr. S. P. Sehegal.

The college name was changed to 'Rangaraya Medical College' in 1961

The Men's hostel south block

The Men's hostel buildings which are located at a distance of ¼ kilometers from the Main College Campus, were inaugurated on 01 October 1962 by Sri. Neelam Sanjivareddy.

The hospital was reorganized with an expenditure of Rs. 36,00,000/- and the bed strength was increased from 750 to 900. The Medical Education Society spent about Rs. 25,00,000/-. During its tenure the Medical Education Society built the 3 storied Surgical block, Orthopaedics block, Cardiology block, the 3 storied Out patient block, the 3 storied Clinical Biochemistry, preventive medicine and Microbiology block, and the Forensic medicine block of buildings. It has also built the Para clinical block for pharmacology and pathology departments, the main Library and lecture halls opposite the Government General Hospital.

The Ladies' hostel

Colonel D.S.Raju, laid the foundation stone to the Ladies hostel in the Main College Campus, on Dt.04 July 1962. It was inaugurated by Dr. Suseela nair on 04 July 1964.

After 1964 the Medical Education Society transferred the management of the Medical college to 'Rangaraya Medical College administrating society'.

Students' canteen in GGH Campus was declared open by Dr T Srinivasan, the then Principal. It was later air conditioned. A small air conditioned meeting hall was constructed on its first floor where APGDA meetings and other small functions are held.

The play ground

Open air Tennis court, Basketball court, Volleyball court and huge playing area (adjacent to Mens' hostel) with a pavilion, Cricket pitches and walking track were provided for the use of the students and faculty.

The Moturu Bhanu Sankar Prasad Memorial College Auditorium

An Auditorium was constructed and declared open on Dt.20th August 1974 by Sri K Rajamallu, Minister for Health, Govt. of AP, with a capacity of 500 seats and with an open stage to the outside to use it as an open air auditorium also. Central Air conditioning was later provided to it in the year 2011.

The Paraclinical buildings

Central Library and Paraclinical buildings were inaugurated by Sri J V Narasinga Rao on 12 December 1969.

Pharmacology and Pathology lecture halls were inaugurated on 12 December 1969 by Sri Thota Ramaswamy, A P State minister for Panchayatiraj. Recently they were Air conditioned to fulfill the MCI norms.

The PG Hostel in the Para-clinical campus

A separate hostel was built for post Post-graduate students in the year 1992 in the Para clinical campus which was located opposite the Government General Hospital and was inaugurated by Dr U Brahmaji Rao, the then Director of Medical Education.

Reading rooms were constructed for the Under-graduate and Post-graduate students in the Para Clinical campus.

The bed strength of the hospital was also enhanced to fulfill MCI guidelines on student bed ratio and also due to increased patient inflow.

Pathology Seminar hall was inaugurated by Smt. S Aruna, A P Minster for Medical and Health on 17 May 2001.

The Anatomy and Physiology lecture gallery was constructed and inaugurated on 17th June 2001 by Sri G M C Balayogi, Speaker, Loksabha. It is presently being expanded to accommodate the increased intake of Undergraduate students.

The Examination halls

Examination halls were constructed in the Main college campus and declared open on 28th July 2003 by Dr K Sivaprasad, Minister for Health, Govt. of AP, as per MCI guidelines.

24 hours Reading rooms were inaugurated in the para clinical compound on 28 July 2003 by AP State minister Sri Tummala Nageswara Rao.

A statue of God Dhanvantari, the Hindu god of Medicine was installed opposite the Auditorium, and inaugurated on Dt 17th August 2007 by Sri M M Pallamraju, Minister of state for Defence, Govt. of India.

The college celebrated its Golden Jubilee in the year 2008. On the occasion NRI alumni of the college constructed a modern library with digital section in the main college campus at a cost of Rs.1 crore plus. This building was completed and started functioning in February 2010.

The Golden Jubilee library – Pokala Sridevi and Nagendrarao Memorial building

In the year 2012 the college reached another milestone by becoming a Super-specialty training centre with the commencement of DM – Neonatology, MCh – Neurosurgery, Paediatric surgery and Plastic surgery.

In the year 2013 the existing facilities in the Digital library section of the Central library were enhanced with the commencement of High speed (100 Mb to 1GB) net connectivity through NKN Project and Free open access Wifi was provided in the 24 hour reading room for students.

In the year 2013 the Medical Council of India gave permission to enhance the undergraduate seats from 150 to 200. Since this meant increased input of lady students an extension to the Ladies hostel is presently under construction. Accommodation in the existing Physiology lecture gallery is also being enhanced to meet the increased intake.

Presently the college has all facilities for teaching Under graduate (200 seats), Post-graduate (111 seats), and 5 Super-specialty students, in addition to Para-medical training to 123 students.

In the year 1977 Government of Andhra Pradesh took over the privately managed RMC. In 1981 Rangaraya Medical College became a full fledged Government Medical College.[2]

Prior to 1962 the annual intake of students is 100. From 1962 the number is increased to 125 and in 1963 the annual intake is again increased to 150. However the MCI brought down this number to 100 in 1974 and later increased to 150. The annual intake is increased from 150 to 200 in the year 2013. The P.G.Diploma courses in 5 disciplines were started in 1972 and the PG Degree courses in the year 1976. The development of the college continued as the student intake in undergraduate and Post Graduate courses increased. Presently the College has all facilities for teaching Undergraduates 200 Nos, Post Graduates 111 Nos and Super Specialty students 6 Nos per year. In addition, the facility of giving Para Medical training to 123 students per year is also available. In the year 2012, the College became a Super Specialty Training Centre.

A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE GOVERNMENT GENERAL HOSPITAL, KAKINADA

The Civil Dispensary:

In September, 1856 a civil dispensary was started in the jagannaickpur area on the southern outskirts of the town (the present day A.S Devi Women's College Premises) under a committee Management. The private dispensary was taken over by the municipality in the year 1871. The hospital consisted of some scattered huts and was administered by a civil surgeon. In 1904, the District Medical Officer's was shifted from Rajahmundry to Kakinada. In steps to expand the hospital were taken in 1908 by the then D.M.O Capt D.G.Roy I.M.S who tire J for the new buildings of the hospital. In 1918 soon after the First World War a need was felt to upgrade the dispensary as a hospital.

On 1-4-1918 the government took over the reins of administration. Major A.L.Patoh M.B.S., became the first Civil Surgeon and District Medical Officer of the hospital. Till 1930 the D.M.O managed the hospital assisted by two sub assistant surgeons. In 1930 another post of sub assistant surgeon was sanctioned along with a portable X-Ray plant. At that time the total hospital staff consisted of one Assistant Surgeon, one lady apothecary three sub assistant surgeons. Four honorary assistant medical officers and ten nurses, in addition to the office staff and attenders. The inpatient strength of 25 was raised to 65, with a daily average outpatient attendance of 190 in the year 1930.

The Lady Havelock Maternity Hospital:-

The Lady Havelock Maternity Hospital was started by the East Godavari District Board in 1895 in the heart of the town (the present day E.N.T and Ophthalmology block) with a generous donation of Rs. 5000/- by philanthropist of Sri Rao Bahadur Badam Venkataratnam of Kakinada. Soon with gracious donation of Maharaja of Pithapuram, a Maternity Hospital was constructed in the adjoining area in 1903. It was opened by his Excellency Lord Ampthill the then Governor of Madras on 04-12-1903.

The Government took over the hospital in September 1926. The site of the present hospital of about 20 acres adjoining the lady Havelock hospital (Neelamvari Thota) was acquired by the government in 1930.

The original proposal to build the hospital in the old hospital campus through sanctioned by the government didn't materialize. After the acquisition of site adjoining the Lady Have Lock Hospital, the construction of the new building was taken up in the year 1936 and completed in the year 1941 at a total cost of Rs.5,79,700/- against the original estimate of 2 lacks in 1915 due to delay in construction.

The District Head Quarters Hospital:-

On 2-12-1941 the new building were declared open by Major H.Stott C.I.E., O.B.E., K.H.S. I.M.S. Surgeon General, Government of Madras. The old hospital in Jagannaikpur was shifted to the new head quarters hospital and the Lady Havelock Hospital was merged with that. The shifting of the hospital from the old to the new building was smoothly done under the careful guidance of the then D. M.O. Captain K.M. Ananthan and the Assistant D.M.O. Dr.W.A.Naidu.

A Complex X ray apparatus was installed consequent on the construction of the new Hospital buildings in 1941. The post of a dark room assistant was sanctioned in 1946 and that of radiographer in 1950.

The bed strength was raised to 185 with a daily average attendance of 600 out patients and 200 in patients. Till 1943 when a separate Military hospital was formed, the hospital took care of the war Casualties of about 139 patients and the hospital also ran an emergency first aid centre in the A.R.P. (Air Raid Precaution) Room the present day gynec special rooms A blood bank was started in 1943 to cater to the needs of the second world war victims with a staff of a compounder a nursing orderly and an attendant.

Honorary Medical Officer System which was commenced in Madras in 1923 was extended to the other mofussal institutions in 1926. The system restructured and reorganized in 1937 was also extended to this institution.

The hospital was recognized to train the mid wives in 1945. The bed strength of the hospital which was 210 in 1946, increased to 300 in 1950-51 and to 400 in 1951-52. In the year 1951-52 the bed strength of the hospital was again raised from 400 to 450. The family planning wing was started in 1955 with a Medical officer, a lady assistant surgeon, a social worker and a health Visitor. Under the five year plan scheme training schemes of 30 compounders, 67 pupil nurses and 40 A.N.M.'s was sanctioned to the hospital. In addition to the family planning clinic, Dental Clinic and District Laboratory (which is now shifted to Rajahmundry) were sanctioned.

In 1956 the hospital had one civil surgeon and 11 assistant Surgeons in addition to Assistant D.M.O. Residential Medical officer (R.M.O.) and Radiologist. In addition there were 14 Honorary Medical officers in categories of Medicine, Surgery, S.T.D. General Ophthalmology, E.N.T., T.B., General-Women, Antenatal and Pediatrics. A cancer therapy unit was sanctioned in 1956 to which the East Godavari District Branch of Andhra Pradesh welfare fund donated Rs.40,000/- to procure 300 units of Radium. Two physiotherapy trained staff nurses were posted to this hospital in 1956.

The Medical personnel connected with the development of the hospital since the beginning in jagannaikpur include Major A.L.Patoh, Major Shappered, Major K.N.Rao, Captain.D.G.Roy, Major General H.Stott, Capt.K.M.Ananthan and Dr.W.A.Naidu.

The dire necessity for expansion of Medical Education to turn out more doctors to cater to the needs of East and West Godavari Districts was keenly felt by the leaders in the medical profession endowed with vision and forethought. A Medical Education Society was founded with Col. D.S.Raju as President and Dr.M.V Krishna Rao as Director/Secretary on 16th April 1958. With the munificent donation of Rs.5.00 lakhs on behalf of Venkat Rayudu Memorial Education Trust by Sri Mullapudi Harishchandra Prasad and from the donations collected from the General Public. The Rangaraya Medical College was started on 17-11-1958. The setting up of Medical College accelerated the development of the hospital which took a quantum leap in bed strength in the speciality care in addition to the teaching and investigation facilities. The head quarters hospital was upgraded to a general hospital by the Government on 14-10-1959 to serve as a teaching hospital. The head quarters hospital was shifted to Rajahmundry.

The Government General Hospital seen a considerable change in the later years. A new casualty block was constructed to manage the increasing flow of patients. Several super specialty departments are being created and their offices are being constructed in the renovated 2nd floor of the main OP building. A new hostel for interneers was constructed as super specialty departments were being housed in the old interneer's hostel at the OP Building. New blocks for Antenatal wards and Pre-op gynecology wards were constructed adjacent to the existing Obstetrics, Gynecology and Pediatrics departments. New buildings were also constructed to house the ENT, Ophthalmology and psychiatry departments and their respective Operation Theaters. An ART(Anti Retro-Viral Therapy) center which caters to the special needs of patients affected with the HIV virus was moved to a new building, It is one of the largest of its kind in India based on the patient volume served giving it a vital role in affecting the epidemiology of HIV in India. Bed strength has been increased to 1085 to sustain the flow of outpatients. :

P4 MEDICINE -THE FUTURE

- Dr.D.Sai Kiran

It's 2030. Santosh picks up a handheld device and holds it to his finger. With a tiny pinprick, it draws off a fraction of a droplet of blood, makes 2,000 different measurements and sends the data wirelessly to a distant computer for analysis. A few minutes later, Santosh gets the results via e-mail, and a copy goes to his physician. All of Santosh's organs are fine, and his physician advises him to do another home medical checkup in six months.

This is what the not-so-distant future of medicine will look like. Over the next two decades, medicine will change from its current reactive mode, in which doctors wait for people to get sick, to a mode that is far more preventive and rational. I like to call it P4 medicine—predictive, personalized, preventive and participatory. What's driving this change are powerful new measurement technologies and the so-called systems approach to medicine. Whereas medical researchers in the past studied disease by analyzing the effects of one gene at a time, the systems approach will give them the ability to analyze all your genes at once. The average doctor's office visit today might involve blood work and a few measurements, such as blood pressure and temperature; in the near future physicians will collect billions of bytes of information about each individual—genes, blood proteins, cells and historical data. They will use this data to assess whether your cell's biological information-handling circuits have become perturbed by disease, whether from defective genes, exposure to bad things in the environment or both.

Several emerging technologies are making this holistic, molecular approach to disease possible. Nano-size devices will measure thousands of blood elements, and DNA sequencers will decode individual human genomes rapidly, accurately and inexpensively. New computers will sort through huge amounts of data gathered annually on each individual and boil down this information to clear results about health and disease.

Medicine will begin to get more predictive and personalized (the first two aspects of P4 medicine) over the next five to 10 years. First, doctors will be able to sequence the genome of each patient, which together with other data will yield useful predictions about his or her future health; it will be able to tell you, for example, that you have a 30 percent chance of developing ovarian cancer before age 30. Second, a biannual assessment of your blood will make it possible to get an update on the current state of your health for each of your 50 or so organ systems. These steps will place the focus of medicine on individual patients and on assessing the impact that genes and their interactions with the environment have in determining health or disease.

In preventive medicine (the third P), researchers will use systems medicine to develop drugs that help prevent disease. If, say, you have a 50 percent chance of developing prostate cancer by the time you're 50, you may be able to start taking a drug when you're 30 that would substantially reduce that probability. In the next 10 to 20 years the focus of health care will shift from dealing with disease to maintaining wellness.

Participatory medicine acknowledges the unparalleled opportunities that patients will have to take control of their health care. To participate effectively, though, they will have to be educated as to the basic principles of P4 medicine. New companies that can analyze human genome variation, like 23andMe and Navigenics, are already planning to provide patients with genetic information that may be useful in modifying their behavior to avoid future health problems. In the future, patients will need not just genetic data but insight into how the environment is turning genes on and off to cause disease—just as smoking often causes lung cancer and exposure to sunlight can cause skin cancer.

P4 medicine will have a big impact on many industries, including pharmaceuticals, food and insurance, as well as health care. The interesting question is whether preexisting businesses and entrenched bureaucracies will be able to respond to these winds of change, or whether a host of new companies will emerge to replace them—focused precisely on these new opportunities.
